Election Notice To All Members

Date: November 29, 2011

A secret mail ballot election for the offices of President, Executive Vice President and Vice President for Love Field is being conducted.

The following were elected by acclamation since only one nominee was submitted: Treasurer – Tryphena Prichard and Recording Secretary – Michele Delorme.

Ballots for this election were mailed to members on or about November 29, 2011. Any eligible member who has not received a ballot in the mail at home by December 2, 2011 or any member who spoils a ballot may request a new ballot by contacting the District 10 Office at (210) 735-8900. If you request and return another ballot, only the replacement ballot will be counted.

Instructions for Mail Voting:

Please read the following instructions carefully before marking and mailing your ballot(s):

- Mark an "x" or place a "✓" in the box next to the name of the candidates of your choice. Do not place your name, initials, or any other identifying information on the ballot(s). Ballots containing any identifying information will be voided.
- Place your marked ballot(s) in the small envelope labeled "Secret Ballot Envelope" and seal it. Do not write on this envelope. You must use the "Secret Ballot Envelope" to insure that ballot secrecy is maintained. Failure to use the "Secret Ballot Envelope" will result in your ballot(s) being voided when the ballots are counted. If your ballot package does not contain a "Secret Ballot Envelope", you may obtain one by contacting the District 10 office at (210) 735-8900.
- Insert the sealed "Secret Ballot Envelope" containing your marked ballot(s) into the return envelope pre-addressed to the Election Committee, Post Office Box 155067, Fort Worth, TX 76155 and seal it.
- Your name on the return ballot envelope will identify you as an eligible voter. Your vote will remain secret because the "Secret Ballot Envelope" containing your ballot will be separated from the return ballot envelope and mixed with other "Secret Ballot Envelopes" before it is opened and the ballot counted.
- Ballot secrecy can only be preserved if you personally mark and mail your ballot(s). Do not allow anyone else to mark or handle your ballot or see how you vote. Do not give your ballot to anyone else for mailing. Do not hand deliver your ballot to anyone?

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

Mail your ballot in sufficient time for it to be received at: Amon Carter U.S.P.S., (South of DFW Airport), P. O. Box 155067, Fort Worth, TX no later than 1:00 PM on December 14, 2011.

The ballots will be counted December 14, 2011 starting at 2:30 PM at the E 21 Break Room, next to Remote Terminal Access in the DFW Airport.

Observers: Each candidate may have a reasonable number of observers, who are members, present throughout the election process, including the tally of ballots.
